**\* Children must have passed the prerequisite swim test in order to participate in the Boating & Sailing Program.** Pass certificates are valid year-to-year if they are on file at the Boathouse. Swim Testing dates will take place in June. Refunds will be issued to participants who do not pass the prerequisite swim test.

## **Supervised Playground Program Registration:**

Neighborhood playgrounds are supervised by Quincy Recreation Department Staff from 8:30 a.m. to 1:30 p.m. during July and August. Free registration will take place beginning **Monday, June 28<sup>th</sup>, 2021** at each location. The Program will continue Monday through Friday until Thursday, August 12<sup>th</sup>. There will be no Program on July 5<sup>th</sup>. Registration is ongoing throughout the summer. Supervised activities are for Quincy residents ages six through sixteen and include: active games and sports for individuals and teams, arts and crafts, and a variety of special events.
