### **Boating and Sailing Registration for Returning Boaters:**

This program is not available to First time boaters or Non-residents at this time. **Sailing, Canoe, and Kayak classes\*** are available Monday through Thursday for children ages 9 to 16 and will **begin on Monday, July 6, 2020**

**\* Children must have passed the prerequisite swim test in order to participate in the Boating & Sailing Program.** Pass certificates are valid year-to-year if they are on file at the Boathouse.

**\* Registration for new boaters** will be held after prerequisite swim tests can be held at a date TBD.

## **Supervised Playground Program Registration:**

Neighborhood playgrounds are supervised by Quincy Recreation Department Staff from 8:30 a.m. to 1:30 p.m. during July and August. Free registration will take place beginning **Wednesday, July 1<sup>st</sup>, 2020** at each location. The Program will continue Monday through Friday until Thursday, August 13<sup>th</sup>. There will be no Program on July 3<sup>rd</sup>.

Registration is ongoing throughout the summer. Supervised activities are for Quincy residents ages six through sixteen and include: active games and sports for individuals and teams, arts and crafts, and a variety of special events. Each playground location is equipped with a bulletin board which will display weekly schedules and important announcements. More information is available on our website, QuincyRec.com.

## **Teamwork 2020**

The Teamwork 2020 program will pair Quincy Police officers with Recreation staff at Kincaide, Parker School, and a Germantown playground on weekday evenings from 5:30 p.m. to 8:30 p.m. Supervised activities for Quincy residents ages six and over include: passive games and sports, arts and crafts, and a variety of special events. This successful program is funded by Senator Charles E. Shannon, Jr. Community Safety Initiative Grant.

## **Happy Acres Program**

Happy Acres is a municipally sponsored summer program for youths with mental or physical disabilities. A wide variety of activities including crafting, boating, nature studies, and sports are offered throughout the dates of the program. Under the supervision of trained and experienced staff, each child is encouraged to compete and learn in accordance with their own level of skills and abilities.
